## MEETING TUESDAY 8TH NOVEMBER 2016

## **BUSINESS/ SERVICES GROUP**

PREVIOUS MEETING 12/10/16- ESTABLISHED A LIST OF POINTS TO BE COVERED, INCLUDING SOME OVER LAPPING THE HOUSING/ENVIRONMENT GROUP.

## THESE POINTS NOW REVIEWED IN ORDER:-

- K.A. 1.) BUSINESS Agreed mainly Agriculture and small businesses latter principally on Knightsbridge Estate. Need to initiate a questionnaire to establish their interests. Group would not wish to see large scale buildings in the village effect on environment/neighbours. O.K. to develop at Knightsbridge. C.W. to provide telephone number to establish a review. Business Rates information from TBC?
- D.S. 2.) SEWAGE. D.S. been in touch with Severn Trent. It seems unlikely there will be any extension of main sewers to the village, possible exception Coombe Hill? Development of Housing likely to need Private Treatment Plant. Developers might be persuaded to provide such a Plant for others? Planning Gain? Some problem with water pressure in Leigh village.
- R.B. 3.) BROADBAND/NETWORK COVERAGE R.B. unable to be present but we understand he has an appointment with a senior B.T. official It is generally agreed that Broadband and Mobile reception is not good despite the extension of fibre optic cable to Ridgeway Farm. Suggestions for Individual Receiver Mast and a Mobile Phone area attachment.
- 4.) HIGHWAYS/ROADS. Points generally considered, largely around surrounding developments at Coombe Hill, A4019 Cheltenham, Longford, Twigworth, Norton. Likely to have massive impact on A.38 usage and Coombe Hill crossroads. Need for Speed Enforcement, M5 Junction 10 re development. Objections to business development between the Old Spot and Coombe Hill.
- 5.) POWER REQUIREMENTS. Discussed need to establish suitability of supply of Electricity. Reports of intermittent failures (temporary) towards Coombe Hill. Could be affected by new

developments proposed at Coombe Hill. Establish any demand for Mains Gas to be brought to village (already at Coombe Hill) Cost? Who pays?

- 5a.) STREET LIGHTING No interest from any of the group in having this. Comment could make it easier to develop in the Village.
- B.T. 6.) AGRICULTURE. B.T. not present. Group satisfied that expansion of existing operations likely to take place. Understood the need for diversification. Generally unhappy if this involved large buildings, but acknowledged that these require Planning and Local Approval in any case.
