This book is drawn to our attention by Ken Poulton. Christopher Somerville moved to Hoefield House in 1952 as a small boy. The first chapter of the book refers to The Leigh his memories and subsequent revisits.

The January Man is the story of a year of walks that was inspired by a song, Dave Goulder's 'The January Man'. Month by month, season by season and region by region, Christopher Somerville walks the British Isles, following routes that continually bring his father to mind. As he travels the country – from the winter floodlands of the River Severn to the lambing pastures of Nidderdale, the towering seabird cliffs on the Shetland Isle of Foula in June and the ancient oaks of Sherwood Forest in autumn – he describes the history, wildlife, landscapes and people he encounters, down back lanes and old paths, in rain and fair weather.

Christopher will be giving a talk at the Suffolk Anthology (17 Suffolk Parade, Cheltenham) on 2 March @ 7pm. Tickets £3 available from the shop.

Get ready for the Horticultural Show, practice making the Lemon Loaf Cake:

Class 61: (over 21's)

Class 65: (21 years and under)

125g butter 175g caster sugar 2 medium eggs 175g self-raising flour pinch of salt 4 tbsp milk 2-3 lemons 100g icing sugar



Method

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°C, gas mark 4. Grease/line a 1kg loaf tin and base.
- 2. Cream together, with wooden spoon or electric mixer, butter and sugar for about 4-5 mins until light and fluffy. Then beat in the eggs and zest of 1 lemon.
- 3. Add the flour and salt, stirring until the mixture is well combined, then add the milk.
- 4. Spoon into the prepared tin and bake for 45-50 minutes or until risen, golden brown and a skewer inserted comes out clean.
- 5. Mix together the icing sugar and 4-5 tbsps of lemon juice to form a runny icing. Drizzle over the hot cake and leave to cool completely before slicing.


