#### CAULIFLOWER COUSCOUS

This wonderfully versatile vegetable is great made into 'couscous'. Just cut a whole cauliflower into chunks, stalks as well but discarding the leaves. Pulse a few times in a food processor and then season with salt and pepper. I usually fry in a little rape seed oil for a few minutes, sometimes adding cooked peas for texture and colour. It can, of course, be steamed. It makes a lovely, lighter topping (raw) for shepherds or cottage pie and any dish where potato is normally used.
